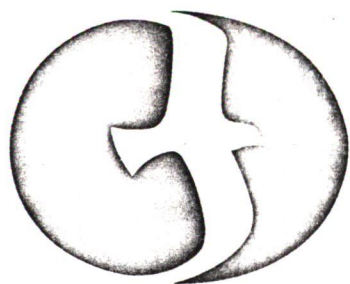

VILLANOVA AND SALVE PRESENT
JOINT CONCERT IN NEWPORT

The Salve Regina College Glee Club will host the Villanova Singers from Villanova University on Friday, March 29, at 8:00 p.m. in Ochre Court. Tickets for the \$2.00 per person concert are available at the door.

The concert will be in three parts. The Salve Regina Glee Club, directed by Mr. Glenn Giuttari, will open the program with a performance of "Stabat Mater," an early classic work by the 18th century Italian composer, Pergolesi. The Glee Club will be accompanied by a string ensemble.

The second part of the program will consist of various selections by the Villanova Singers who are directed by Mr. Herbert Fiss. Songs performed by the Villanova group will range from classical pieces to modern compositions.

A combined chorus will complete the concert with a performance of "TeDeum" by Vincent Persichetti. Persichetti is a modern American composer and his work, "TeDeum," was commissioned in 1964 by the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association.
