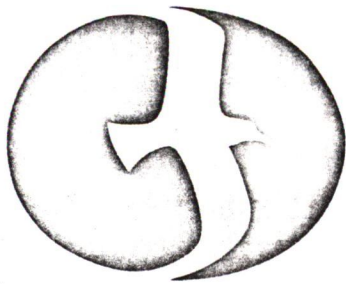

SALVE PRESENTS BALLET DEMONSTRATION

Salve Regina College will present Herci and Myles Marsden in the "World of Dance" on Wednesday, March 27 at 9:00 a.m. in Ochre Court. Mr. Myles Marsden, artistic director of the State Ballet of Rhode Island, and his wife, Herci, will provide a lecture/demonstration on dancers and their world. Admission is free.

The presentation will be educational and entertaining. Mr. Marsden will open the program with an informal talk on the dance while Herci Marsden demonstrates different types of artistic interpretation through dance. The finale will be a full costume performance by the Marsden's of the "pas de deux" from "The Sleeping Beauty."

The Marsden's have been trained in the traditions of classical Russian ballet. Myles Marsden was the first American graduate of the International Ballet School in Split Yugoslavia and later rose to premier danseur of the Yugoslav National Ballet. Herci was a soloist with the same company.

In addition to their deep involvement with the State Ballet of Rhode Island, the Marsden's are the founders of the Brae Crest

School of Ballet Education in Lincoln, R. I., and Brae Crest Studio II at Swanhurst on Bellevue Avenue, Newport. Mr. Marsden is also an associate professor of psychology at URI Extension Division, where he teaches a course in dance therapy.
