

#### C. G. JUNG LECTURE AT SALVE

"Dream Symbolism and Jung" describes a special lecture on the famous psychologist C. G. Jung at Salve Regina College on Tuesday, April 30, at 8:00 p.m. in O'Hare Academic Center. Speakers for the evening will be Dr. Luther Martin and Dr. Stanley Yarian of the University of Vermont. Admission is free.

Jung, the most famous student of Sigmund Freud, developed a theory on the "collective unconscious" which postulated a common bond of symbols among all cultures and nations of man. Jung said these symbols would vary in form from culture to culture, but all nevertheless relate to common themes. Moreover, Jung said these symbols could take many forms and be expressed through religion, art, music, literature, etc.

Dr. Martin will speak on dream symbolism or Jung's interpretation of these common symbols through dreams. While he is lecturing, Dr. Yarian, a former professor at the Rhode Island School of Design, will show slides of these symbols as expressed in art. Following their presentation there will be time for questions and answers.
