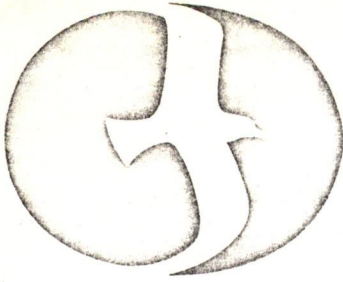

SUMMER SESSION SET AT SALVE

Salve Regina College, Newport, R. I., will hold two six-week summer school sessions this summer. The first will run from June 3 to July 12, and the second from July 15 to August 23. Classes will be held two days a week in both the day and evening.

Dr. William Burrell, dean of the college, says courses can be taken for credit or for self-enrichment. "People interested in our summer session can take courses toward a degree or just to learn about a subject that interests them," he says.

The college is offering over 150 graduate and undergraduate level courses. In the creative arts, the college has arranged courses in ceramics, film making, weaving, Reader's Theatre and many other fine and applied arts. For teachers, a complete schedule of courses in education and special education is available. Salve has also arranged a full listing of basic college courses in all areas including business, biology, chemistry, history, English, languages, math, music, nursing, psychology, sociology, religious studies and law enforcement.

"If we haven't got exactly what a student is looking for," adds Dr. Burrell, "we will work with him to design independent study projects in the particular area he is interested in. In other words, we'll try to 'custom design' a program of study for

students participating in our summer school."

Registration for both summer sessions at Salve will be held at the college during normal working hours from May 20-30. A special evening registration will be held on May 23 and late registrations will be taken until the first day of classes.
