Salve Regina To
Offer Evening of
Baroque Music

Early French music will be offered in concert, in tribute to French assistance during the American Revolution, at Salve Regina College, July 13, at 8 P. M.

Music of various eighteenth century French composers will constitute the evening concert. Instruments of the period, viz., harpsichord, violin, viola da gamba, have been chosen for the best interpretations of the Baroque music. Performing are Earl Eyrich, Michael Goodson, Priscilla Hallberg, and Marsha Vleck.

Ochre Court, the main building at Salve Regina, will be the setting of the concert. Modeled after the great Middle Age chateaux of France's Loire Valley, the house is almost a perfect replica of Edward VII's castle in Paris.

Intended as a tribute to the French who assisted the American revolutionaries in their struggles against England, this evening of music is one of the Bicentennial activities at Salve Regina this summer.

The program is open to the public, and there is no admission fee.
