Admissions representatives from thirty-five New England colleges will participate in a college-day program on September 24, at La Salle Academy, Providence.

The program is an attempt to acquaint the students and parents of the Rhode Island area with the diversity of collegiate opportunities, and the range of academic areas of study offered by the participating colleges.

Participating institutions include eleven Rhode Island colleges: Barrington College, Brown University, Bryant College, Johnson and Wales, Mt. St. Joseph College, Providence College, Roger Williams, R. I. Junior College, R. I. College, Salve Regina College, and U.R.I. Connecticut colleges attending are Albertus Magnus, Annhurst and St. Joseph's (West Hartford). Eleven Massachusetts colleges plan to participate: Anna Maria, Aquinas Junior College, Assumption, Boston College, Holy Cross, Our Lady of the Elms, Emmanuel, Laboure Junior College, Merrimack, Regis, and Stonehill. From New Hampshire: St. Anselm's, Mount Saint Mary (Hookett), Notre Dame, (Manchester), and Rivier College. Vermont institutions participating include: St. Michael's, St. Joseph the Provider, St. Joseph (Old Bennington), and Trinity College. St. Francis College of Biddeford, Maine, and St. Joseph's College of North Windham, Maine also plan to attend.

On the 24th, the morning sessions will be for the benefit of high school counselors, and the afternoon sessions for students and parents.
