Under the direction of Glenn Giuttari, the Newport College Singers of Salve Regina College, Newport, will be the feature performers, and will be joined by guest artists Susan Fleet, (baroque and piccolo trumpets) and J. Kimball Darling, (organ.) The program will feature sonatas for trumpet and organ by Fantini, Viviani, and Torelli, and an organ work by Alain. The Singers will perform the Missa Brevis of Benjamin Britten, Litanies a la Vierge Noire of Poulenc, and the Laudate Dominum of Charpentier.
