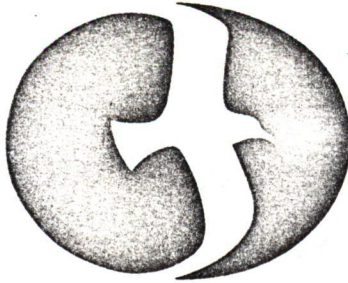

"EDUCATION BEYOND THE INTELLECT"
DISCUSSED AT SALVE

"Education Beyond the Intellect: the Resurrection of the Soul and the Body," will be the subject of a talk and slide show by Salve Regina College Philosophy professor, Dr. James Hersh, on Tuesday, December 9, in O'Hare Academic Center. His lecture is open to the public without charge and begins at 7:30 p.m. in room 260. It is the fifth presentation in Salve's "Aims of Education" lecture series which began in September.

Dr. Hersh is an Assistant Professor of Philosophy at Salve Regina and has been a member of the college faculty since 1971. He is a graduate of DePauw University and holds his doctorate from The Union Graduate School. Before coming to Salve Regina, Dr. Hersh served on the faculties of DeKalb College, the Lovett School and the Study-Travel-Community School. He has also taught part-time at Providence College.
