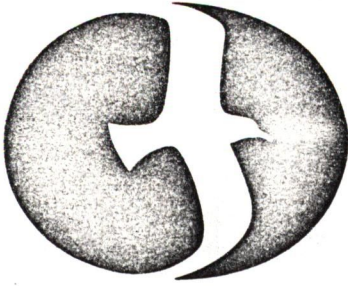

PARENTS WEEKEND AT SALVE

Parent-Student classes are just one of the many activities scheduled for the approximately 400 persons who are expected on campus at Salve Regina College October 25 - 26 for the school's 14th Annual Parents Weekend.

Parents Weekend festivities officially get underway at 9:30 A.M. Saturday morning with registration and a coffee hour in Ochre Court where parents and students will have a chance to visit with members of Salve's faculty and administration. Next, a variety of 25 minute parent-student classes on such topics as "The Sounds of Silence," "Newport's Role in the American War for Independence," and "Society and the Three Laws of Thermodynamics," will be held at 11:00 and 11:35 A.M. in O'Hare Academic Center, followed by a buffet luncheon in Miley Hall.

The Newport College Singers will perform for visiting parents and guests at 2:00 P.M. in Ochre Court and the remainder of the afternoon will be set aside as free time for parents to tour the campus or visit historic Newport.

A gala Parents Weekend Dinner will be held Saturday night at the Sheraton Islander, followed by an evening of dancing from 9:00 P.M. to midnight in the Great Hall of Ochre Court.

Brunch Sunday morning in Miley Hall and Mass in the College Chapel will conclude the weekend's activities.
