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### "Jewish-Christian Dialogue" Lecture at Salve

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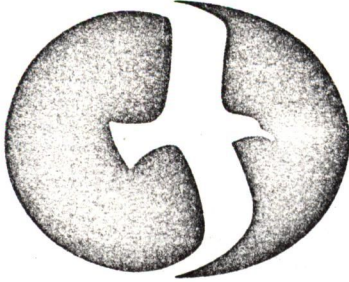

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"JEWISH-CHRISTIAN DIALOGUE" LECTURE AT SALVE

Rabbi James B. Rosenberg, spiritual leader of the Barrington Jewish Center, Barrington, Rhode Island, will speak on the "Jewish - Christian Dialogue: Present Position and Future Possibilities" Tuesday, October 28, 1975 at Salve Regina College. His lecture, sponsored jointly by the Jewish Chautauqua Society and the Salve Regina Department of Religious Studies, will be held at 8:00p.m. in O'Hare Academic Center, Room 260. An informal coffee hour will follow Rabbi Rosenberg's talk, which is open to the public without charge.

He lectures on college campuses throughout New England for the Society in an attempt to create a better understanding of Jews and Judaism through education.
