OPEN HOUSE AT SALVE REGINA

More than 1,000 persons from throughout New England will get a first hand look at Salve Regina College Sunday afternoon, November 2, when the Newport College hosts its annual Open House for prospective students and their families.

Open House gets underway at the college at 1:00p.m. with guest registration in O'Hare Academic Center, and will continue until 4:30p.m. Representatives from the Admissions Office, which is sponsoring the event, will be on hand to explain admission requirements and conduct campus tours with the assistance of a number of Salve Regina student hosts, who will also direct visitors to group sessions on the college's various degree programs. All dormitories, the college library, and the school's academic buildings will be open to guests during the Open House.

Three thirty minute group sessions are planned to give interested persons an opportunity to meet faculty members and discuss specific areas of study and student services. College personnel will also be available to discuss financial aid, transfer counseling, curriculum advising, tutorial programs, student activities and veterans assistance.

Group sessions will be held on the following programs: art, criminal justice, education and special education, English, theatre, speech and journalism, history, management, modern languages, music, nursing, philosphy and religious studies, psychology, sociology and the sciences (biology, chemistry, physics, math and medical technology).

A concert by the Newport College Singers will conclude the Open House.
