Grants totaling more than 8200 (amount) will be distributed to SEVEN (number) privately supported colleges and universities in PA (state) this week by The Sears-Roebuck Foundation, a spokesman said today.

In the NEWCAST (city) area, SAVIE REGINA (names of colleges and universities) ROGER WILLIAMS will receive grants totaling 7600 (amount).

The PA (state) colleges and universities are among almost 1,000 private accredited two- and four-year institutions across the country which are sharing in \$1,250,000 in Sears Foundation funds for the 1976-77 academic year. Funds may be used unrestrictedly as the colleges and universities deem necessary.

In addition to its unrestricted grant program, The Sears-Roebuck Foundation each year conducts a variety of special-purpose programs in elementary, secondary, higher, and continuing education. Altogether, the Foundation had expenditures of over \$2,500,000 in 1976 for its education activities.
