HEALTH CARE TRILOGY TO BE OFFERED BY SALVE

Salve Regina, The Newport College announces the addition of another course to the list of its Credit-Free Education Courses which will be offered during March, April and May 1977. The additional Course is a Health Care Trilogy, which will study three aspects of Health Care for those working in this field.

Dr. Frank Maguire of the Department of Religious Studies at Salve Regina College will lead a series of three two hour discussions on the subject of "Coping with Death and Dying." The discussions will focus on the medical, psychological, social and spiritual aspects of death and dying as reflected in the recorded experience of a dying person.

The discussions will take place at Salve Regina College, O'Hare Academic Center on March 9, 16, 23 from 3:45-5:45 p.m. Enrollment will be limited to thirty persons.

Mrs. Shirley Hill, a member of Salve's Nursing Department will teach the April series entitled "Patient Assessment," which will be given on April 12, 19, 26 from 7:00-9:00 p.m. in Room 206, O'Hare Academic Center.

The third section of the trilogy will be given by Ms. Patricia Murray, associate professor of Sociology at Salve Regina College. The title of her presentation will be "Discharge Planning for Health Care Personnel." This will run May 10, 17, 24 from 7:00-9:00 p.m. in O'Hare Academic Center Room 206.

Salve Regina College does not issue C.E.U.'s, however, this course has 6 contact hours which are equivalent to .6 C.E.U.'s (Continuing Education Units).
