WORKSHOP ON "CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT" TO BE HELD AT SALVE

On Tuesday, March 15, Salve Regina, The Newport College will host an all day Workshop on "Child Abuse and Neglect." The Workshop will open with an address by Dr. Peter Kosseff, Ph.D., Director of the Adolescent and Children's Services Program of the Newport County Community Mental Health Center. During the remainder of the morning and afternoon, the following workshops will run concurrently; all participants will be able to attend two workshops.
