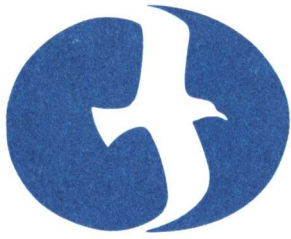

### Thirty-Three Municipal Clerks Receive Certificates

An important milestone in the annals of the New England Association of City and Town Clerks was the awarding of thirty-three Municipal Clerk Certificates. The state dining room of Ochre Court, on Salve Regina, The Newport College's campus was the scene of this event. The recipients of the CMC had attended three successive one week workshops at Salve Regina College during the past three years. The certificate represents 100 class hours on such topics as report writing, intergovernmental relations, municipal fiscal policy, computer application, records management, the legal aspect of municipalities motivation and personnel management, and the uniform real estate practices act. The regional certificate gives each recipient 50 points towards certification on the national level.
