SISTER LUCILLE MCKILLOP TO RECEIVE HONORARY DEGREE

Sister Lucille McKillop, Salve Regina College President, will receive a Doctor of Humane Letters Degree (Honoris Causa) from Roger Williams College, Bristol, Rhode Island on September 28, 1977.

The ceremony will be held at the special Fall Convocation on September 28, 1977. Roger Williams College is the third Rhode Island College to award Sister Lucille with an honorary degree in recognition of her outstanding accomplishments in the role of presidential leadership.

Bryant College, in 1976, Smithfield, Rhode Island awarded Sister Lucille with the Degree of D.S. in B.A. and Johnson and Wales College, Providence, Rhode Island awarded her with a doctoral degree in June 1977.
