Orientation week at Salve Regina, The Newport College will begin on

Sunday, September 26 with a reception for Parents of new Students.

The Parents Council will host the reception at Miley Hall from 1 to

4 p.m. Sunday afternoon. There will be a reception at Carey Hall also which will be hosted by Student Activities.

Two hundred and sixty-three Freshmen will be attending SRC this academic year of whom two hundred and twenty-three will be resident students. The resident enrollment has increased to the extent that it has been necessary for the College to operate eight dormitories, an increase of five since 1974. The Freshmen Class will have representatives from eleven States and two foreign countries.
