The program will included the following pieces: 3 Sonatas by Domenico Scarlatti; a work entitled 32 Variations in C Minor, WoO 80 by Beethoven; several Waltzes from Op. 39 by Brahms; Suite bergamasque by Debussy and 2 Preludes by Rochmaninoff. Admission to the Recital is \$1.00 for Salve students and \$1.50 for the general public.

He was a member of SRC's music department for three years. He was a Guild Judge, 1976 National Guild of Piano Teachers Auditions, in West New York, New Jersey. He has been an instructor and recitalist with the Young People's Symphony of Rhode Island Music Camp, 1973-1975. Mr. Massoud recently attended the Seminar in Piano Teaching held each summer at George Peabody College for Teachers, in Nashville, Tennessee. He gives solo and chamber performances throughout Massachusetts and Rhode Island. He has performed with the Fall River Symphony, 1966 and 1976. Mr. Massoud is presently a resident of Fall River, Massachusetts.
