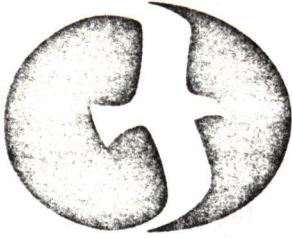

### CLASSICAL GUITAR RECITAL

On Tuesday, February, 1978, Vincent Fraioli, Classical guitarist, will give a recital at Newport College, Salve Regina. Mr. Fraioli, a graduate of the University of Rhode Island, has studied with Hibbard A. Perry and Tom Greene of Brown University, and most recently with Rey de la Torre of New York. His solo recitals include performances at the Westerly Arts Festival, Galleria La Sfinge in Italy, Carnegie Hall and two performances at Salve Regina College in 1976. He has appeared as guest performer at the Rehoboth Music Festival and with the Rhode Island Philharmonic.

He is presently instructor of guitar at R.I. Junior College and R.I. College and has taught privately since 1969.

The recital will be held in Ochre Court and start at 8P.M. The program will include works by Manuel de Falla, J.S. Bach, Domenico Scarlatti and others. The event is sponsored by the Fine Arts Committee at Newport College, Salve Regina and admission is \$1 for general public and 50¢ for students.
