THE ARTS FEATURED IN SALVE SUMMER WORKSHOPS

The Newport College - Salve Regina will hold five special workshops in the Arts on the campus this summer. Quilting, Sketching the 19th Century Mansions, Lettering in Stone, Photography, and Sacred/Liturgical Art are among the subjects offered in concentrated workshops.

Mrs. Janice Buffington will teach the Techniques and Varieties of Quilting which will cover all phases of this favorite pastime from designing quilts to the finished product. Workshop begins June 7 and will run on Monday and Wednesday, 6:00 p. m. to 9:00 p. m. until July 18.

Sister Arlene Woods, MFA, will conduct a class in "Sketching: 19th Century Newport Mansions" from July 5 to August 4. Students will work out-of-doors on site at Ochre Court and at the Preservation Society mansions. Interior motif of the Beaux Arts period will

Mr. John Hegnaer of the John Stevens Shop will introduce the art of calligraphy in stone. This two week workshop running Monday to Friday, 8:30 - 11:30 a. m. from July 5 - July 18 will cover the study and practice of lettering.

Sister Arlene Woods and Mr. Mel Lieberman will team teach "Photography as a Resource for the Painter."

Aimed toward the painter and person who works in the graphic media, this workshop will concentrate on techniques to record scenes so that interpretive graphics can be made at a later date under more controlled conditions.

This workshop will run Mondays and Tuesdays, July 16 to August 8 from 9:00 - 11:00 a. m.

Ade Bethune, local and world famous liturgical artist and craftsman will conduct a week's workshop, July 24 - July 31. Sacred/Liturgical Art, the artistic expression of Christianity as found in sacred images will provide the content of this workshop.
