### SALVE REGINA COLLEGE RECEIVES HUD LOAN

Senator Claiborne Pell was the guest speaker at the Salve Regina College Alumni Brunch on Sunday, October 1, at the Sheraton Islander Inn in Newport. Senator Pell said that he was very pleased to announce that Salve Regina College has been awarded a direct loan of \$328,000 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development for energy conservation improvements to six dormitories. This will enable the College to make important structural modifications which will realize a 10% reduction in heating cost. The six dormitories where energy conservation improvements will be made are: Conley Hall, Miley Hall, McAuley Hall, Moore Hall, Ochre Lodge and Founders Hall.

Sister Lucille McKillop, President of The Newport College - Salve Regina, was in attendance at the Alumni Brunch and thanked Senator Pell for his continued interest in Salve and in particular for his help in obtaining this HUD loan for the College.
