McMANUS IS CERTIFIED MUNICIPAL CLERK

Jane A. McManus, city clerk of Newport, has become a Certified Municipal Clerk (CMC) after completing a three-year education program for professional clerks held at the Newport College - Salve Regina. She was presented the CMC certificate by Dr. William Burrell, vice president/dean of faculty at Salve, Friday evening, August 15 at graduation ceremonies in Ochre Court.

CMC means that a clerk has had professional education among municipal clerks and has had access to educational resources that foster future growth among muncipal clerks and leadership in their profession.
