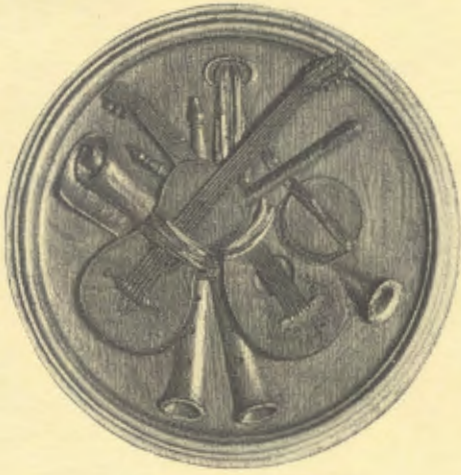

THE NEWPORT COLLEGE - SALVE REGINA

David Pelton, tenor, will perform Wednesday, October 15 at 8 p.m. in the first of a series of "Concerts at Ochre Court" to be held at The Newport College - Salve Regina. Offering music from the Baroque era to the present, Pelton will be accompanied by Stephen Martorella who will play the Butler harpsichord and piano. The concert is open to the public and free of charge.

Pelton, a native of Potsdam, N.Y., graduated from South Kingstown High School (South Kingstown, R.I.). He holds an A.B. degree from Cornell University, a master of music degree from Boston's New England Conservatory, and in 1979 he was awarded his doctoral degree at the University of Cincinnati/College Conservatory of Music.

As a tenor soloist, Pelton has toured England, France, Spain, the Soviet Union and Italy. He has given recitals throughout New England, the East and the South and has performed with several orchestras in oratorio and as soloist. He has also performed in opera in concert and on stage.

Pelton served as director of choral music and instructor in music at Colgate University and was a teaching fellow at the University of Cincinnati/College Conservatory of Music. Currently, he is an assistant professor/artist-in-residence at Texas Wesleyan College in Fort Worth.
