GRANT FROM SEARS - ROEBUCK FOUNDATION FOR SALVE REGINA

The Newport College - Salve Regina has received an unrestricted grant from The Sears - Roebuck Foundation. Accepting the award today from Sears representative John P. Pelletier was Sister Lucille McKillop, College president.

Salve is one of eight private colleges and universities in Rhode Island to receive unrestricted financial support from Sears. Grant money this year totals \$12,400. Rhode Island colleges and universities are among over 1,000 private, accredited two-and four-year institutions across the country sharing in \$1,500,000 in Sears Foundation funds for the 1980-81 academic year. Grant money may be used as colleges and universities deem necessary.

Approximately 1800 undergraduate and graduate students, the largest number in the history of Salve Regina College, are enrolled for the 1980-81 academic year.
