ACCREDITATION RENEWED FOR NURSING DEPARTMENT AT SALVE

The Newport College - Salve Regina Department of Nursing has received renewal of its accreditation from the National League for Nursing (NLN). The NLN Board of Review for Baccalaureate and Higher Degree Programs based its decision on the self-study report submitted by Salve Regina and the visitors' report.

Approximately 500 students are enrolled in the College's baccalaureate degree program, the largest department enrollment at the college. Twenty-eight faculty, full-time and part-time, teach in the Nursing Department at Salve.

Curriculum in the College's Department of Nursing recognizes the contribution of nursing and other disciplines in meeting health needs of a diverse society. It also recognizes the past, present and emerging roles of the professional nurse, and the need for students to develop the skills of critical thinking.

The Department of Nursing is accredited for the major in nursing and for graduates of diploma and associate degree programs.

Salve Regina is accredited by the New England Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools.
