SALVE REGINA - THE NEWPORT COLLEGE RECEIVES CONTINUING
ACCREDITATION FOR 10 YEARS

Salve Regina - The Newport College recently was approved for continuing accreditation for a period of 10 years by the Executive Committee of the New England Association of Schools and Colleges.

Accreditation approval was based on a recommendation by the Commission on Institutions of Higher Education. The Commission commended the College for significant progress in many areas, including enrollment growth, quality of institutional planning, clarity of mission and the leadership provided by Salve's administration and board of trustees.

According to Sister Lucille McKillop, College president, "This re-accreditation is viewed by the administration and board of trustees as an evaluation of the dedicated efforts and sustained commitment of faculty and staff, and as a reaffirmation of a Catholic College with a well-defined mission and realistic plans for a successful future."
