POTTERS FROM "GREAT AMERICAN BOWL" EXHIBITION TO DEMONSTRATE CRAFT AT SALVE REGINA - THE NEWPORT COLLEGE

On Saturday and Sunday, April 17 and 18, a workshop in conjunction with "The Great American Bowl" will be held at the ceramics studio in Mercy Hall at Salve Regina - The Newport College.

The workshop will be conducted by potters David Davison and Brian Vannostrand, who were invited to display their works at "The Great American Bowl" show currently being exhibited at The Art Association in Newport.

The work of Davison and Vannostrand contrasts sharply. Davison's work is sculpturally oriented, tied to the traditions of pottery making in a metaphorical sense. Vannostrand considers himself less a sculptor and more of a production potter. His work, done with simple tools,

has a tendency to reflect the more traditional idea of what a craftsman is.

The workshop will begin at 9 a.m. Saturday with working demonstrations and slide presentations. It will conclude on Sunday following a special gallery presentation at the Art Association at 2 p.m.
