HONORS CONVOCATION, ALUMNI WEEKEND
HELD AT SALVE REGINA - THE NEWPORT COLLEGE

More than 700 people, including Governor J. Joseph Garrahy attended the 1982 Honors Convocation at Salve Regina College held Saturday, May 1 on the terrace of Ochre Court.

Approximately 150 students received awards at this event, held annually to recognize and honor Salve students who have excelled in leadership and service to others.

This year's valedictory address was presented by Mary Beth Cordeiro, a resident of Westport, Mass. Cordeiro, an elementary education major with a minor in psychology, achieved a grade point average of 3.99 out

Dr. Lucille McKillop, R.S.M., president of the College, also named Wendy Ashcroft of North Dighton, Mass. the 1982 recipient of the Salve Scholarship. Ashcroft, a nursing major, who will be a junior next year, was awarded the scholarship for earning the highest grade point average of both the sophomore and junior class. The scholarship will cover the full cost of her tuition next year.

In addition to pre-commencement activities, Alumni Weekend for the Salve classes of 1952, '57, '62, '67, '72 and '77 also took place. Almost 200 alumni and their families came for the weekend which included campus tours, reunion parties and a dinner/dance at Ochre Court.

New officers of Salve's Alumni Association were installed during a Sunday brunch at the Canfield House, and Carol Radcliffe Keogh ('57) received the Outstanding Alumni Award for her work with Providence's Hmong Indo-Chinese refugees.
