### THOMAS FLANAGAN APPOINTED TO NEW ADMINISTRATIVE POSITION AT SALVE REGINA -- THE NEWPORT COLLEGE

Thomas P. Flanagan has been appointed director of administration in academic and student service areas at Salve Regina -- The Newport College, it was announced today by Sister Lucille McKillop, College president.

Prior to joining the Salve administration, Flanagan was professor of management and executive assistant to the chairman of the management department at the Naval War College, Newport. In addition to teaching executive-level decision-making seminars at the War College, Flanagan was responsible for the management department budgeting and academic scheduling. He also taught defense economics, an executive development course, to more than 300 U.S. and international military officers, and senior U.S. government officials.

Since 1980, Flanagan has been employed at Salve Regina as a part-time

faculty member in the management department teaching, "Management of Human Resources." He will continue on as a Salve instructor, teaching this course on both the graduate and undergraduate levels.

Flanagan, a Newport resident and retired U.S. Army Colonel, holds a bachelor of science degree in public relations and a masters degree in education from Boston University. His military career spans 22 years and includes specialized service in the areas of personnel administration, logistics research and management, manpower training and administrative support.

Flanagan has served as a personnel specialist in the Office of the Secretary of the Army, as a Commander in Vietnam and in various Army leadership positions in this country and abroad, particularly France and Germany.

Flanagan's new responsibilities as a full-time administrator at Salve include budgeting management in academic and student service areas, personnel (non-faculty) development, management of College manuals, statistical reports and development of new academic programs, assisting with the College's transition to computerized record-keeping, and liaison services between the office of the College provost and other administrative and academic areas.
