SALVE REGINA - THE NEWPORT COLLEGE HOSTS THREE-DAY WHOLISTIC HEALTH WORKSHOP

Salve Regina - The Newport College will host the three-day workshop, "A Celebration of Life - the exploration of human potential and consciousness," Friday through Sunday, August 19-22.

The workshop will focus primarily on a variety of wholistic approaches to health, including body movement, the Alexander Technique, Gestalt therapy and psychosynthesis, but will also include folk dancing and celebration of life.
