"Legal Aspects of Special Education Legislation and Litigation," an educational workshop designed for parents, teachers, administrators and lawyers will be offered July 26-August 5 at Salve Regina - The Newport College.

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in education and a Ph.D in special education and rehabilitation from Boston College.
