**"SALVE REGINA COLLEGE DANCE FOR HEART" MARATHONERS  
TO SOLICIT PLEDGES DURING OCEAN STATE RUN**

More than one type of marathoner will be on the streets of Newport this Sunday during the seventh running of the Ocean State Marathon. Students from Salve Regina - The Newport College, contestants in the second annual 20-hour dance marathon November 12 and 13 at the College, will be soliciting pledges from spectators following the Ocean State runners. The event will benefit the Rhode Island affiliate of the American Heart Association.

Last year, the College raised almost \$5,000 for the American Cancer Society. This year's goal is \$10,000. One-hundred-twenty students will be soliciting pledges along the marathon route wearing special "Salve Regina College Dance for Heart" T-shirts.
