COPY of the decision of the United States Board of General Appraisers.

We find that Mr. Austin Baldwin imported into the Port of New York, certain household furniture and furnishings, which are claimed to be entitled to free entry under Paragraph 516, Act October 1st., 1890, or under paragraph 524 of said Act.

That the same were imported July 14th., 1893 and duty assessed upon portions thereof as Silk embroidery, under Paragraph 413, and upon other portions, as finished furniture composed of wood and silk, wood chief value.

We find that none of the same are antiquities, that the same has not been used abroad by the owner not less than one year.

We have no evidence to sustain the claims in this protest, and it is overruled.
