Dear Sir:

We beg to advise you that the Board Of Appraisers have decided on our protest No. 63537a, upon shipment marked "A.B. 952/4 956/7I ex. Ss. "La Touraine". July, 1893, and herewith enclosed please find the report of the said Board.

When this case was called on Fe. 1st, our representative was present as requested by your office in order to have the case continued, and to have it come up at the same time with your other cases, and said request was granted, but the Board, by error, took up the case and now have decided it against you. Mr. Bishop called upon the Board of Appraisers this morning, but the Chairman stated as the case has been decided, he could not open it again, and could do nothing, but if you wish to take the case to Court it could be done, as you have thirty days to appeal from this decision.

We give you this timely notice of the matter, in order that you may consult your legal advisors and take immediate steps in the matter.
