ROBERT KULO APPOINTED TO
INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNOLOGY CENTER AT SALVE

Robert Kulo has been appointed Director of the Instructional Technology Center at Salve Regina College. Robert Kulo has been a member of the faculty of English and Speech at Salve for the past ten years. Currently, he teaches both on the undergraduate and graduate levels.

Mr. Kulo introduced the Communication discipline as a minor in the English Department at Salve. He also established the campus Readers' Theatre Club and Forensics Club. Mr. Kulo coordinated the Bicentennial Youth Debates in Rhode Island and has served as a member of the Christmas in Newport Association. He is a member of the Faculty Senate, the College Judicial Board, and is the Chief Marshal of the College.

Each summer, Mr. Kulo has served as an instructor in the annual New England Municipal Clerks Institute and has been an instructor in adult education for the local community and special interest groups. Prior to joining Salve, Mr. Kulo was an instructor at San Diego State University.

Mr. Kulo is a member of several professional associations. These include: the Speech Communication Association, the Eastern States Communication Association and the New England Playwrights Guild. He also serves as a member of the Diocesan Committee for Public Access Television. Mr. Kulo frequently speaks before area business and civic organizations.

Currently, Mr. Kulo holds a Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study from Boston University, an M.A. from San Diego State University, and a B.A. from San Diego State College. His major fields of study are human communication and educational media and technology. He is completing studies towards the Ed.D. from Boston University.
